## Statewide Standard Test Prep:

This is a seasonal program in Winter and Spring. Students will take tests and there will be detailed review and explanation from

Master Reading and Vocabulary (K~8): In this program, students are assigned a book to read and expected to complete a homework sheet about the book. Then, they take reading comprehension test. Students' Homework and Reading Comprehension Test will be reviewed thoroughly by experienced instructor in the class. This class will not only provide students with important analytical reading and writing skills but also help students in preparation for standardized tests such as NJ ASK and SAT. In addition, students will read advanced reading comprehension passages (mainly informative passage) to increase their critical reading and writing skills. Students will explore a variety of genres including fiction, non-fiction, poetry, and/or biography. There is also intensive vocabulary enrichment study.


Power Writing (3~12):
Student will write a first draft for homework before class. Then, an instructor will review the student's essay thoroughly based on standard Rubric of Essay for 30 Minutes. In the second half of the session, student will re-write the essay as Final Essay based on teacher's revision and recommendation that are centered on organization grammar, vocabulary, creativity, and idea development. A variety of essay topics that fall under narrative, descriptive, creative, or persuasive will enhance the student's writing skills and style. This course is one hour per session.

## Junior SAT English (8-10):

This class covers reading comprehension, grammar, vocabulary, and essay writing for High School students. Through this class, students will build essential and fundamental Critical Reading and Writing Skill.

## Private Tutoring for All Subjects:

Private tutoring for all subjects is available upon request.

HS Math / Honors Math / Smart Math: After taking a mandatory diagnostic test (to find out student's strengths and weaknesses), students are given individualized materials according to how they did on the test. Students work through the problems in their book according to their own pace. With the help skilled instructors, students can set longterm goals. For academically advanced students, this program will help them excel even higher in math. For students who are struggling in math, this program will bring up their confidence in math through lots of practice. Additionally, this class will enable students to be well advanced in their grade level and perform higher on standardized tests such as PARCC and SAT.
