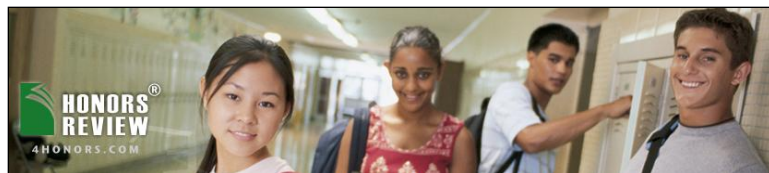
The new PSAT will be administered in October 2015 while the redesigned SAT will be available in March 2016. With such significant changes to the SAT, practice is essential now more than ever.
