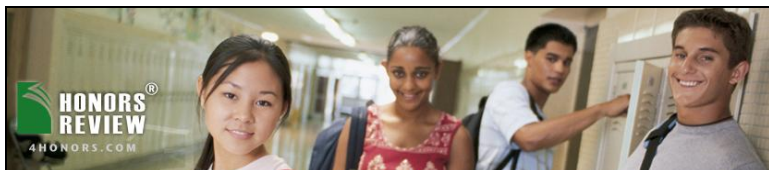

News Articles Reading & Writing (4th - 8th)
